This song is a great opportunity to discuss about poverty and people in need all around the world.

I bring 10 questions to be discussed about. Conversation classes are tricky sometimes. Some people don't like to share their real opinions because of various personal reasons.

So, before I start any conversation with new students I always make it clear for them that the goal of the class is the ability to discuss about a specific topic, not his or her real opinion, (although it's important to keep a good discussion going on).

Let it be clear that nobody is in the class to be judged for anything.

Also when the topic is a bit more tense, try to make the environment more light for the students and yourself.

- 1. What is the cause of poverty?
- 2. What do you think the govern should do to solve problem in its country?
- 3. What do you think the citizens could do?
- 4. Is it possible to end poverty around the world? Why? Why not?
- 5. Why do people live on the streets?
- 6. Do you give money to beggars? Why? Why not?
- 7. Have you ever helped any charity campaign?
- 8. What do you think about people receiving welfare?
- 9. Would you eliminate the welfare system?
- 10. Would you ever consider working for a charity program?

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
