Let it be clear that nobody is in the class to be judged for anything.

Also when the topic is a bit more tense, try to make the environment more light for the students and yourself.

4. Is it possible to end poverty around the world? Why? Why not?
5. Why do people live on the streets?
6. Do you give money to beggars? Why? Why not?

8. What do you think about people receiving welfare?
9. Would you eliminate the welfare system?
10. Would you ever consider working for a charity program?
